Action Without Borders – www.idealists.org

Lists over 20,000 nonprofit and community organizations in 165 countries, which can be searched by name, location or mission. Also includes job and internship listings and a directory of products and services to nonprofit organizations.

Association of Fundraising Professionals – www.afpdallas.org

Provides chapter and event information and general fund raising news.

Catalog of Federal Domestic Assistance – www.cfda.gov

A complete listing of federal grant programs, projects, services and activities that provide assistance or benefits to the public. It includes summary program descriptions and is searchable by keyword.

CNM Connect – www.cnmconnect.org

(formerly the Center for Nonprofit Management) provides a calendar of classes and seminars to enhance management skills of managers in nonprofit organizations, information about their consulting services and short term loan program.

Chronicle of Philanthropy – www.philanthropy.com

Provides news summaries of its top stories, some full text articles, announcement of conferences, application deadlines and job opportunities in the nonprofit community.

Council on Foundations – www.philanthropy.com

Contains information for grant-making foundations and corporations. Provides resources to help grant makers set up and administer effective giving programs.

Federal Register – www.federalregister.gov

A publication of proposed rules and regulations, grant announcements and notices from federal agencies. This database is searchable from 1995 to present.

Foundation Center – www.foundationcenter.org

The Foundation Center is an independent national service organization that provides authoritative information on foundation and corporate giving. The site contains many useful links to foundation information, a short course on proposal writing, a free newsletter, *Philanthropy News Digest*, and an excellent frequently asked questions section.

Offers grant seekers information about the Center's library, upcoming workshops, volunteer and nonprofit job opportunities and local networking resources.

Provides a centralized location for grant seekers to find and apply for over 1,000 federal grant programs.

Contains a complete list of training seminars on proposal writing and strategic fundraising across the U.S. It also provides links to nonprofit resources for accounting, finance, legal information, online fundraising, research, newsgroups and employment.

A service of the Foundation Center that provides easy-to-use, self-service tools and resources to help nonprofits worldwide become more viable grant applicants and build strong, sustainable organizations.

GuideStar – www.guidestar.org

A searchable database of more than 850,000 nonprofit organizations, public charities and private foundations that includes the organization's assets, revenue, liabilities and expenditures.

Provides summary information on more than 4,000 companies with links to their web sites and to Internet business newspapers.
